

**RYE TOWNSHIP  
VACANCY BOARD MEETING  
February 19, 2019**

**PRESENT:** Vacancy Chairman: Robert Lightner, Supervisor Jim Sabo and Supervisor John Stahl, Daisy Lightner, Secretary/Treasurer, and John Schulze.

The meeting was held at the municipal building and called to order at 7:00 PM by Vacancy Board Chairman, Robert Lightner. Proof of publication for this meeting is on file. Vacancy Chairman Lightner convened the meeting with the pledge of allegiance to the flag.

**CITIZEN PARTICIPATION:** Vacancy Board Chairman Lightner asked if there was any citizen participation at this time. None was offered.

**APPOINTMENT OF SUPERVISOR:** Vacancy Board Chairman Lightner explained that this special meeting of the Vacancy Board is being held in compliance with the Second Class Township Code to appoint an individual within fifteen (15) days to fill the position on the Board of Supervisors left vacant with the resignation of former Supervisor Ken Quigley on January 7, 2019. The term of the appointment for this vacancy would be for the remainder of this year to December 31, 2019. This year is a municipal election year. The individual appointed is required to file a petition to have their name on the ballot for the primary election in May and win in November to fill the remaining two years of Mr. Quigley's term.

Upon due discussion and consideration, Supervisor Jim Sabo made a motion with a second from Supervisor John Stahl to appoint John Schulze to the Board of Supervisors to fill the vacancy left with the resignation of Ken Quigley. Motion carried with all members voting in favor.

The Board expressed appreciation to resident, John Schulze, for his willingness to accept this appointment. The Secretary indicated she would prepare the Oath of Office for John to take before assuming his duties as supervisor at the regular Board meeting on Monday, February 25, 2019.

The Board directed the Secretary to update the Perry County Emergency Dispatch Center Call Out listing to include John Schulze as the newly appointed supervisor. John Schulze provided his cell number. Supervisor Sabo requested that his cell number also be provided to the County as he does not always answer his home phone.

It was brought to the attention of the Supervisors that the outside light on the western end of the building is malfunctioning and flickers off and on. This light has had issues previously and it may be time to purchase a new light. The Board asked the Secretary to notify the road crew to check the light when the weather permits.

**ADJOURNMENT OF THE MEETING:** There being no further discussion or business before the Board, Vacancy Board Chairman Lightner made a motion and Supervisor Sabo seconded to adjourn the meeting at 7:20 pm. Motion carried unanimously.
